Introduction and Purpose of Workshops:

The purpose of each workshop was two fold. First, to give participants a status report on Arkansas Game and Fish Commission's deer management program and to describe what has brought us to this point. Secondly, to get staff input and advice related to the task of producing a new, statewide deer management plan.

This report is based on information provided from eight staff workshops [in Batesville, Little Rock, Ozark, Mt. Ida, Camden, Hope, Brinkley, and Jonesboro during June 11 – 22, 2007].

Description of Workshop(s) Process:

Each table was an independent work group of usually 5-8 people per table. To begin with, participants were asked to identify a person to write the group's ideas on the flip chart paper provided at each table. Next, they were asked to identify someone who would serve as a spokesperson for each group/table.

Participants were asked to provide 2 different types of information:

- A. issues or concerns or problems about deer and deer management in Arkansas, and
- B. advice, recommendations, or suggestions concerning actions that should be taken regarding deer management in Arkansas

After listing issues and advice on separate sheets of flip chart paper, participants were asked to decide the single most significant idea identified at each table. When finished, a person at each table gave a verbal report on that table's single most significant idea. Then after a few brief closing remarks, on the way out, participants were asked to put sticky dots on those items that they, as individuals, thought most important.

Summary by Region:

A grand total of 94 AGFC staff participated in all 3 regional workshops. The following summary groups comments into Very, Very Important Items and Very Important Items but the items listed within those groupings are not ranked by priority.

Region 1 Ozarks, Arkansas River Valley, Ouachita Mountains (Ozark, Mount Ida, Batesville, Little Rock) = 30 total participants for region 1

Very, very important items:

1. Regulations:
 - a. Eliminate 3-point rule (all antler point restrictions)
 - b. 1st buck of choice
 - c. Eliminate feeding and baiting
 - d. Regulations are too complicated
 - e. Gun season opens too early
2. Federal and State owned lands:
 - a. Lack of deer on public lands
3. Deer herd management:
 - a. Over harvest of bucks
 - b. Make sound management decisions based on biological parameters

Very important items:

1. Regulations:
 - a. Eliminate antler point restriction on public lands
 - b. Archery season is too long
 - c. Eliminate hunting deer with dogs
 - d. Gun season is too long
 - e. Put the fun back into deer hunting
 - f. Conduct regulation process every 3 years
 - g. Reduce season length but increase bag
 - h. Need an adhesive deer tag
 - i. No restrictions on youth as for sex or antler restriction until bag limit is reached
2. Federal and State owned lands:
 - a. More funding for habitat management on public grounds
3. Deer Management Units and Zones:
 - a. Increase zone quota permits in zone 11
 - b. Zone doe quota permits – especially zone 8
 - c. Zone boundary alterations, including WMA re-numbering and renaming
4. Deer herd management:
 - a. Eliminate captive cervids
5. Recruitment:
 - a. Not enough youth hunting opportunity (days and bag limit)

Region 2: West Gulf Coastal Plain (Hope, Camden) = 31 total participants for region 2

Very, very important items:

1. Regulations:
 - a. Eliminate point restrictions and reduce buck limit
 - b. 1st deer = buck of choice; 2nd = 4 point rule; or 1-4 point rule, 1 buck of choice in any order
 - c. Buck of choice – possibly random harvest

- d. Increase hunting opportunities
- 2. Federal and State owned lands:
 - a. Need more access to public lands
- 3. Deer herd management:
 - a. Captive wildlife is an issue
 - b. More attention is needed to balance buck/doe ratios

Very important items:

- 1. Regulations:
 - a. Simplify regulations
 - b. Allow at least some type of antler restriction, a minimum at least. Some type of antler restriction.
 - c. Deer checking – no online checking – 24 hour check for archery only – firearm ASAP
 - d. Eliminate high fence enclosures
 - e. Harvest doe mandatory before harvesting a buck. Increase bag limits in zones that will sustain additional harvest.
- 2. Federal and State owned lands:
 - a. Conservation easements; buy more land
- 3. Deer herd management:
 - a. Define quality – set benchmarks , define quantity – set benchmarks
- 4. Recruitment:
 - a. Liberalize doe harvest/relax antler restrictions for hunters less than 16 or over 65. Relax regulations for youth in the youth hunt. Increase public land opportunities.
 - b. Youth or hunter recruitment (women and elderly) involvement

Region 3: Mississippi Alluvial Valley, Crowley’s Ridge (Brinkley, Jonesboro) = 33 total participants for region 3

Very, very important items:

- 1. Regulations:
 - a. Commissioners should make decisions based on recommendations from biologists, not personal opinions
 - b. Point restrictions – how they are implemented; do they work?
 - c. More doe harvest opportunities – either sex hunt
 - d. Current muzzleloader season is set too early in the year – statewide
 - e. Gun season length and timing is an issue
- 2. Deer herd management:
 - a. More emphasis should be placed on the biological data collected in setting deer regulations

Very important items:

- 1. Regulations:
 - a. Eliminate baiting
 - b. Online checking – encourages dishonesty
 - c. Lift shotgun restriction
 - d. Date of birth on permit application for kids – not hunter education card
 - e. Simplify regulations, refer to deer tag and regulation content
 - f. Deer limit straight across, do away with advertising in regulation book, simplify regulation book

- g. Regulations are too complex and too many
 - h. Set long-term regulations (3 years)
 - i. Close gun season in zone 4 – archery only
 - j. Only give one tag with license and additional tags given as deer are checked
2. Education:
- a. Better educate public about deer management and biological information
 - b. Lack of biological/management information making it to hunters is an issue
