

Aquatic Resources Education Program

Seminar/Clinic Request

The Aquatic Resources Education Program provides seminar/clinic programs on many topics. We use the following guidelines to distinguish between a seminar and a clinic. A seminar is done in a classroom or auditorium type setting. A clinic is usually held outdoors. Some clinics are held at a body of water where fishing is a part of the clinic. The following list of topics are available for your groups needs.

Fishing 101: Basic instruction for the beginning angler. Topics covered include; knot tying, bait section, fish biology, and casting.

Catfishing 101: Basic instruction on how to catch channel catfish. Topics included are; knots, rigs, baits, safe handling and where to fish.

Trout Fishing 101: Basic instruction on how to catch rainbow trout. Topics included are; knots, tackle selection, baits, rigs and where to fish.

Casting 101: Basic casting instruction. Casting games can be included.

Beginning Lure Craft: Students are instructed on feeding habits of black bass. The predator/prey relationships are discussed. The students then design four lures (top water, minnow type, shad body and deep diver). When finished with this step they are asked to share with the other students their design logic. The student is then given a blank of each type lure to paint and complete for later use.

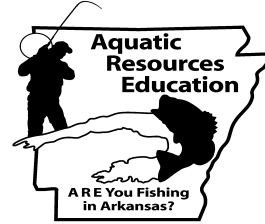
Beginning Fly Tying: Students are taught basic fly tying principles and instructed in the construction of a wooly bugger.

Fish Arkansas: This is a PowerPoint presentation on where to fish in Arkansas and what species are available. The presentation takes approximately 1 hour.

Aquatic Careers: Discusses careers available in the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission with an emphasis on fisheries careers.

ARE Programs: We give a presentation on current programs available from the Aquatic Resources Education Program (Mobile Aquarium Program, Fishing Derby Program, Classroom Aquarium Program, Tackle Loaner Program, Seminar/Clinic Program).

Other: We can provide instruction on almost any topic in the Arkansas angling world. Intermediate and advanced level topics can be handled. If you would like to custom fit a topic to your needs please use the other information section on the request form.
